TINARIWEN: April 16th at the Palace of Fine Arts Theatre (SF Jazz)

Tinariwen stands as an icon of freedom and resistance among the nomadic Tuareg, one of the oldest and proudest peoples on earth. Over the past two decades this mesmerizing group of guitar-poets from the southern reaches of the Sahara Desert has transposed traditional melodies to the electric guitar, mixing them with blues, rock, Berber and Arabic influences.

SEUN KUTI & EGYPT 80: April 19 at the Palace of Fine Arts Theatre (SF Jazz)

Seun Kuti is carrying on the family business, spreading his father Fela Kuti's glorious Afrobeat revolution around the globe. The Nigerian vocalist and multi-instrumentalist started performing with his father's raucous band Egypt 80 at the age of eight, eventually taking over leadership of the horn-laden 16-piece ensemble after his father's death in 1997. Like his older brother Femi Kuti, who also leads a powerful Afrobeat band, Seun honors Fela's legacy while putting his own spin on the relentlessly funky Afrobeat sound.

RICHARD BONA and LIONEL LUEKE: May 17 at the YBCA Forum (SF Jazz)

Cameroonian bassist Richard Bona and Beninese guitarist Lionel Loueke have taken the New York scene by storm, catapulting to all-star

status through their own innovative bands and prolific sideman work with the likes of Joe Zawinul, Herbie Hancock, Terence Blanchard and many others among the jazz elite. In joining forces for this exclusive West Coast date, they take the next step in an extraordinary creative journey, forging a new "world-jazz" sound rooted in similar life paths: Both were born in Africa and educated in Paris; both possess gorgeous, pure voices; and both display overwhelming instrumental prowess.

CéU: May 9 at the Herbst Theatre (SF Jazz)

CéU is a 29-year-old vocalist from São Paulo with a soft, insinuating voice and a taste for reggae, jazz, samba and R&B filtered through gauzy electronica textures. Her eponymous 2007 debut on San Francisco's own Six Degrees Records sold nearly 100,000 units, quickly shooting to the top of *Billboard's* World Music chart and earning two Grammy®-award nominations.

Mandingue music is the name given to the traditional music of countries like Guinea, Gambia, Mali and part of Senegal. It is more indigenous to Mali than any of the other countries aforementioned.. It is a distinct sound easily recognized because of the powerful vocals of the singers who are called griots or praise singers, and the use of traditional instruments such as the kora (a type of African harp), the balafon (a wooden-keyed xylophone) the tamana (talking drum) and the n'goni (a small guitar-like instrument). All these are used along with electric guitars, keyboard and drum kits giving Malien music its modern feel.
